Position Summary:

The position consists of the following general duties (this is not an exhaustive list):

- Conduct learn to swim program and other related events and activities in accordance with our methodology and instructions as specified by the managers.
- The swim school may open seven days a week, therefore possible sessions may range from Monday to Sunday. This may change from time to time at the discretion of the managers. The aquatic industry is essentially a seasonal industry and as such available hours will vary according to demand and profitability.
- Learn to swim teachers will primarily be responsible for teaching pupils to swim but does not exclude the possibility of other duties that may be required in the normal course of operating a swim school. (ie Duties such as reception, cleaning, etc)
- Understand the importance of consistency and continuity when teaching learn to swim and endeavour to commit to the agreed upon sessions for the season/term.
- Provide brief updates to parents on the progress of their child's swimming.
- Participate in staff training sessions as scheduled by managers.
- Endeavor to do additional hours to cover for absent employees as the need arises – ie illness, holidays etc
- Must be available to work a minimum of 6 hours per week unless working on a weekends

Key Responsibilities/Authorities:

- Supervise pupils under the teachers program in accordance with the approved program and directions of the managers.
- Ensure equitable treatment and attention of all pupils regardless of personalities or skill level.
- The safety and supervision of the children under the teachers care is your first and most important priority.



- Inform managers of any equipment or property requiring repairs or maintenance.
- Assist the company to achieve its aim of providing lessons, which encourage pupils to achieve water safety or improve water skills in a caring, safe environment.
- Attend selected meetings from time to time as directed by the managers.
- Refrain from acting or being seen to act, in conflict with the owners best interests.
- Maintain a positive and co-operatively disposition with staff, customers and pupils.
- Respect and utilise the property and equipment provided by the owners for use in the teaching programs.
- The managers may need to alter hours and lessons schedules from time to time and will inform affected employees of such changes.
- No authority to hire or fire staff or bind the company via agreement.
